In pursuance of the provisions of clause (3) of Article 348 of the Constitution of India, the Governor is pleased to order the publication of the following English translation of notification No 1046/ xxx -4-2012-4(04)/2010 dated 07 December, 2012

In exercise of the powers under section 96 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act no. 59 of 1988) read with section-21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Act no. 10 of 1897) the Governor is pleased to make following rules with a view to amending the Uttar Pradesh Motor Vehicles Rules, 1998 after previous publication in Government notification no. 965/30/4/12/4(4)/2010, dated 19 October, 2012 as required under sub-section(1) of section 212 of the said Act of 1988:-

The Uttar Pradesh Motor Vehicles (Thirteenth Amendment) Rules, 2012

Short title and commencement

1. (1) These rules may be called The Uttar Pradesh Motor Vehicles (Thirteenth Amendment) Rules, 2012

(2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in the Gazette.

Amendment of rule 162

2. In the Uttar Pradesh Motor Vehicles Rules, 1998, for rule 162 set out in column 1 below, the rule as set out in column 2 below shall be substituted, namely:-

162 Painting of Motor Vehicles-(1) Subject to Rule 110 and sub-rule (2) a motor vehicle of four-wheel drive such as jeep and command cars which originally belonged to the military shall be painted in any of the following colours: (a) White, (b) Black, (c) Green,	162 Painting of Motor Vehicles-(1) Subject to rule 110 and sub-rule (2) a motor vehicle of four-wheel drive such as jeep and command cars which originally belonged to the military shall be painted in any of the following colours: (a) White; (b) Black; (c) Green;

(2) Every motor-cab shall be painted in black colour with a yellow hood and no other motor car shall be painted in this colour combination:

Provided that this sub-rule shall not apply to tourist motor cabs and motor cabs of foreign make horse power twenty four and above.

Explanation- for the purposes of this rule tourist motor cab means a motor cab to which a contract carriage permit is issued by the state Transport Authority mainly for the conveyance of foreign tourists.

(3) No motor vehicle other than military motor vehicle shall be used in any public places unless it is painted in any colour different from those usually used for military motor vehicles.


(2) Livery motor-cab permitted to ply exclusively within city area, shall be painted in black colour with a yellow hood and no other motor car shall be painted in this colour combination:

Provided that colour or colour combination for CNG operated three wheeled vehicles shall be such as may be decided by the State Transport Authority or the concerned Regional Transport Authorities, as the case may be:

Provided further that this sub-rule shall not apply to the motor cabs specified in rule 85A of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1939.

(3) Contract Carriage, other than those specified in sub-rule(2) shall be painted in any colour other than maroon or black or red colour with a maroon fluorescent horizontal ribbon of five centimeters and with at centre of the exterior of the body of such vehicle and the words "Contract Carriage" shall be mentioned on two sides of the "contract carriage" within a circle of sixty centimeters diameter in case of other than motor cab and within a circle of twenty five centimeters diameter in case of motor cab.

(4) No motor vehicle other than military motor vehicle shall be used at any public place unless it is painted in any colour different from those usually used for military motor vehicles.
